

ICFRE signs MoU with ITTO

Promoting Quality Timber Production in Smallholders and Community-based Teak and Other Valuable Species Plantations in the Tropics



The Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education (ICFRE) has signed an MoU on 06 November 2024 with International Timber Trade Organisation (ITTO) to execute a project on Promoting Quality Timber Production in Smallholders and Community-based Teak and Other Valuable Species Plantations in the Tropics (ITTO Project: PP-A/54-331A). Considering the vast genetic resources of teak, its large scale cultivation of teak in the country and the expertise with the Indian Institutes, ITTO has included India as one of the partnering institutions. ICFRE-Institute of Forest Genetics and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore is the implementing Agency. This Project will result in the production of high-quality timber and the efficient processing of timber and timber products.
